Synopsis: On March 12, 2002, a civil action was filed against ATK in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of California. National Metal Technologies (NMT) had a contract to supply ATK with ammunition links for the ammunition production business. The charges alleged that ATK breached this contract, violated antitrust laws, and interfered with competition and, therefore, the plaintiffs were entitled to damages of \$30 million. The case was settled for \$6 million on March 24, 2005.

Synopsis: In March of 1997, Alliant Techsystems was charged with allegedly overcharging the Navy for labor costs on contracts dealing with the Intermediate-Range Nuclear Forces Treaty. The complaint was made by a former employee of Alliant and co-defendant Hercules, Inc. under the False Claims Act, 31 U.S.C. § 3729, et seq., and filed in the U.S. District Court in Los Angeles. The complaint alleges that the companies falsified labor hours and led employees to do so. Each company agreed to settle for \$2.25 million, or a total of \$4.5 million.
