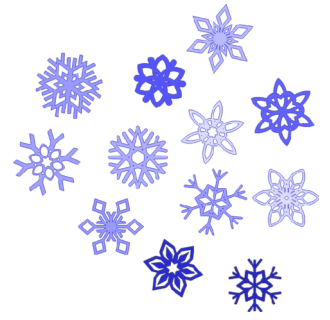


MEEC All School Newsletter
