Addendum to Parent Handbook, Revised 8/6/2021

MEEC Safety Protocol During Coronavirus Pandemic

- 1. All staff will do a daily self-health assessment. Staff must not work if they are sick.
- 2. All unvaccinated staff will wear face coverings.
- 3. Parents are permitted to enter the building for drop off and pick up of children. Please wait outside of your child's classroom door. Covid-19 safety protocol initiated by the Health and Safety Board of Bethel Lutheran Church insists that all parents and caregivers who enter the building must wear a face covering regardless of their vaccination status. Parents and caregivers must exit the building promptly after drop off and pick up.
- 4. All children's hands will be sanitized upon entry into the classroom.
- 5. Prior to snack time, children will be assisted and supervised in hand sanitizing. Staff will wear gloves when distributing snack.
- 6. In between morning and afternoon sessions, the bathroom, tables, chairs, counter tops, doors, and any other high-touch surfaces will be disinfected.
- 7. Any child who exhibits symptoms of fever, coughing, sneezing, or excessively runny nose will need to go home. Parents will be called and the child will wait in an isolated area away from other children.
- 8. Prior to going home staff will supervise and assist children in hand sanitizing.
- 9. If anyone in your household is awaiting the results of a Covid-19 test, your child or anyone in your household may not come to school until the results of the test indicate negative. The director must be notified of any Covid-19 testing within your household.
