SpotLight On: Ms. Jen and Ms. Sharon P. What makes MEEC's speech and language therapy special? Ms. Jen and Ms. Sharon! In addition to extensive experience with preschool children, both of our SLPs (speech-language pathologists) are experts with using sensory integration techniques to enhance speech-language therapy. Using the swings, climbing equipment, balls and other movement activities stimulates the vestibular system, which translates to better language processing and production. Winter weather is on the way! To find out if classes are canceled due to bad weather you can:

1. Check the MEEC website. We will post school closing information on the Weather Policy Page (www.meec.us).
2. Check the local TV morning news programs. Middleburg Early Education Center will be listed if we are closed.
3. Call MEEC at 440-888-9922. If we are closed, we will update the voice mail message to reflect that. However, if the power is off at MEEC, the voice mail does not answer the phone. If this happens, check using one of the other methods. (If there is no power at MEEC, there will be no classes!)
4. You will receive a REMIND notification. Ask in the office if you need help setting it up.

The information will be posted as soon as it becomes obvious that the conditions make closing necessary. Sometimes that's the night before a school day, sometimes it's the morning. We try to have everything updated and posted by 7:00 a.m.

How sick is too sick for school? This can be a tough question to answer. When faced with this problem, here are some things to consider.

1. Will my child be comfortable in the classroom?
2. Will he/she be able to participate in all activities?
3. If my child were healthy, would I want another child with these symptoms playing with my child?

Children who have symptoms of contagious illnesses should not attend classes to protect the health of other children and staff. **Children must be fever free for 24 hours without medication, and must be free of vomiting and diarrhea for 24 hours before returning to school.**
