(Mark 10:17-31)

- 1) Covetousness assumes goodness is a function of human resource and success.
- 2) Covetousness values the trappings and privileges of wealth beyond all else.
- 3) Covetousness resists Jesus' "extreme" requirements for discipleship.
- 4) Covetousness keeps moral people blind to the true nature of their spirits.
- 5) Covetousness bars people from entrance into the Kingdom of God.
- 6) Covetousness seeks a material, temporal payday in the present.
