## It Is Easier for a Camel to Go Through the Eye of a Needle than for a Rich Man to Enter the Kingdom of God

(Mark 10:17-31)

1)	Covetousness assumes goodness is a function of human <u>resource</u> and <u>success</u> .
2)	Covetousness values the <u>trappings</u> and privileges of <u>wealth</u> beyond all else.
3)	Covetousness resists Jesus' "extreme" requirements for discipleship.
4)	Covetousness keeps moral people <u>blind</u> to the true <u>nature</u> of their <u>spirits</u> .
5)	Covetousness bars people from <u>entrance</u> into the <u>Kingdom</u> of <u>God</u> .
6)	Covetousness seeks a <u>material</u> , temporal <u>payday</u> in the <u>present</u> .
