Born Again on the Wrong Side of the Tracks, Part 4

- 1) We are born again into a life of guaranteed hope. (vss. 3-5).
 - a. Our hope is sure because of Jesus' resurrection.
 - b. Our hope is a priceless inheritance reserved for God's children.
 - c. Our hope is not subject to the ravages of time and decay.
 - d. Our hope is protection by God's power for our final salvation.
 - e. Our hope is revealed in the end for all to see.
- 2) We are born again into a life of <u>purposeful trials</u>. (vss. 6-7)
 - a. Trials of our faith are evidence of God at work in us.
 - b. Trials of our faith are God's means of refining us.
 - c. Trials of our faith are a witness to the unregenerate.
 - d. Trials of our faith are our means of glorifying God.
- 3) We are born again into a life of joyful faith. (vss. 8-9)
 - a. Faith in Jesus Christ is based in hope.
 - b. Faith in Jesus Christ is essential to <u>love</u>.
 - c. Faith in Jesus Christ is experienced as joy.
 - d. Faith in Jesus Christ is realized in salvation.
- 4) We are born again into a life of <u>mysterious salvation</u>. (vss. 10-12)
 - a. Salvation through Christ's suffering was once not <u>fully known</u>.
 - b. Salvation through Christ's suffering was revealed through His Spirit.
 - c. Salvation through Christ's suffering was spoken by servant-prophets.
 - d. Salvation through Christ's suffering was an unexpected strategy.
 - e. Salvation through Christ's suffering is not yet fully known, even by angels.
