## Keeping Bad Company (Mark 2:13-17)

1)	Keeping bad company trusts the <u>grace</u> of Jesus' <u>elective</u> call.
2)	Keeping bad company holds that Jesus must go to sinners.
3)	Keeping bad company reckons that no sinner is irredeemable.
4)	Keeping bad company constructs no hierarchy of sinners.
5)	Keeping bad company <u>fears</u> not moral <u>contamination</u> by sinners.
