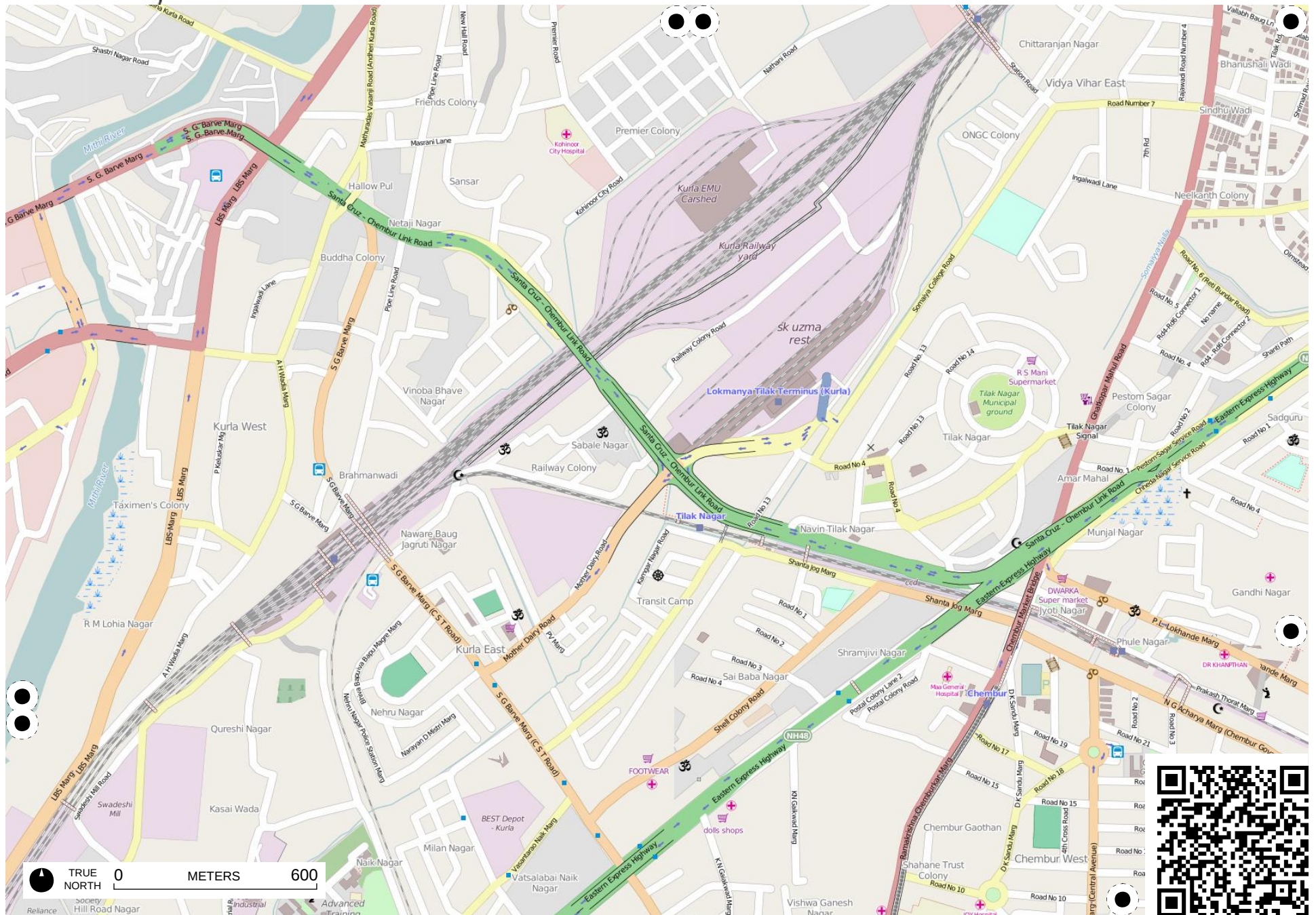

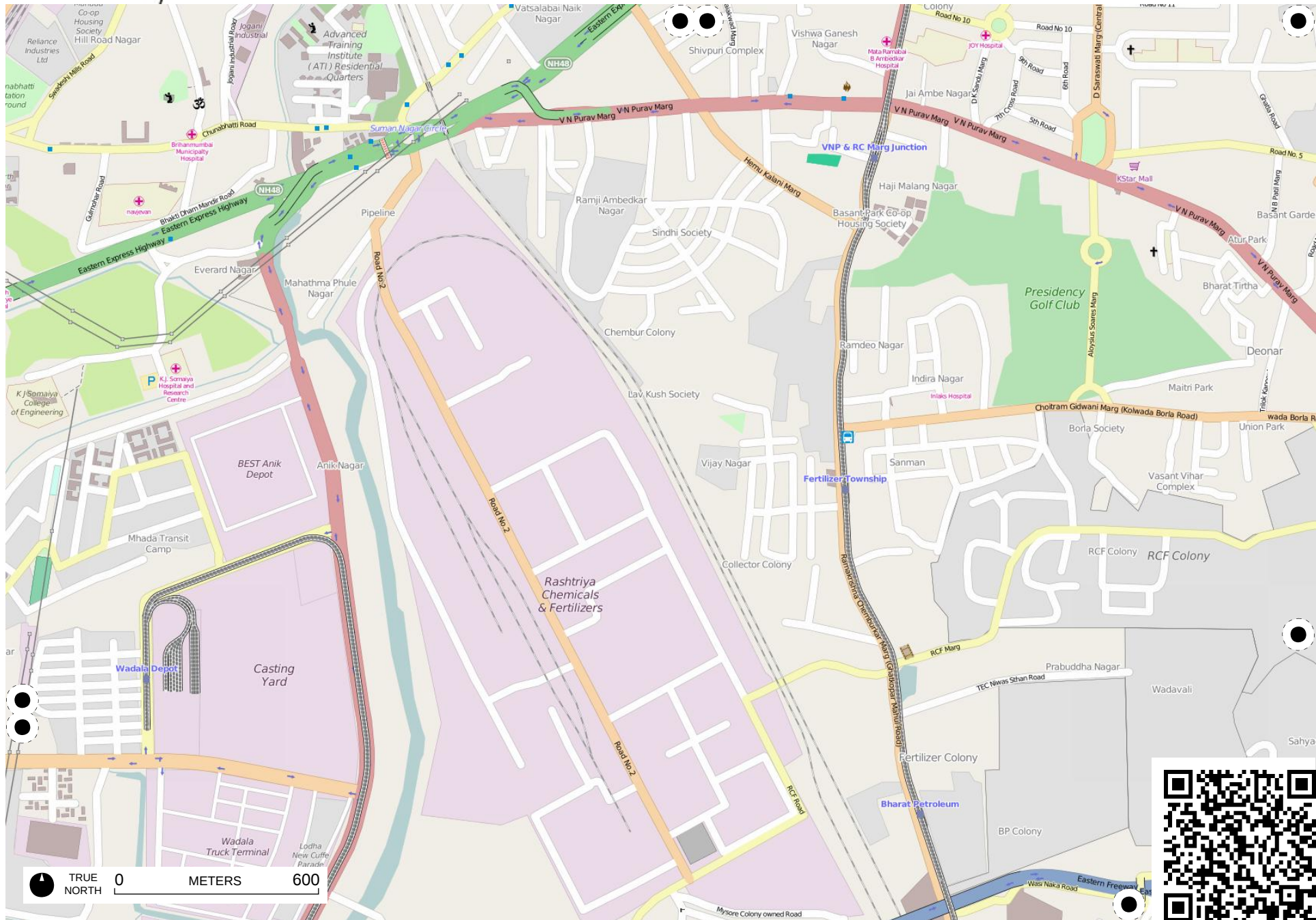

This map illustrates the Wadala area in Mumbai, India, centered around the Eastern Express Highway (NH48). Key features include:

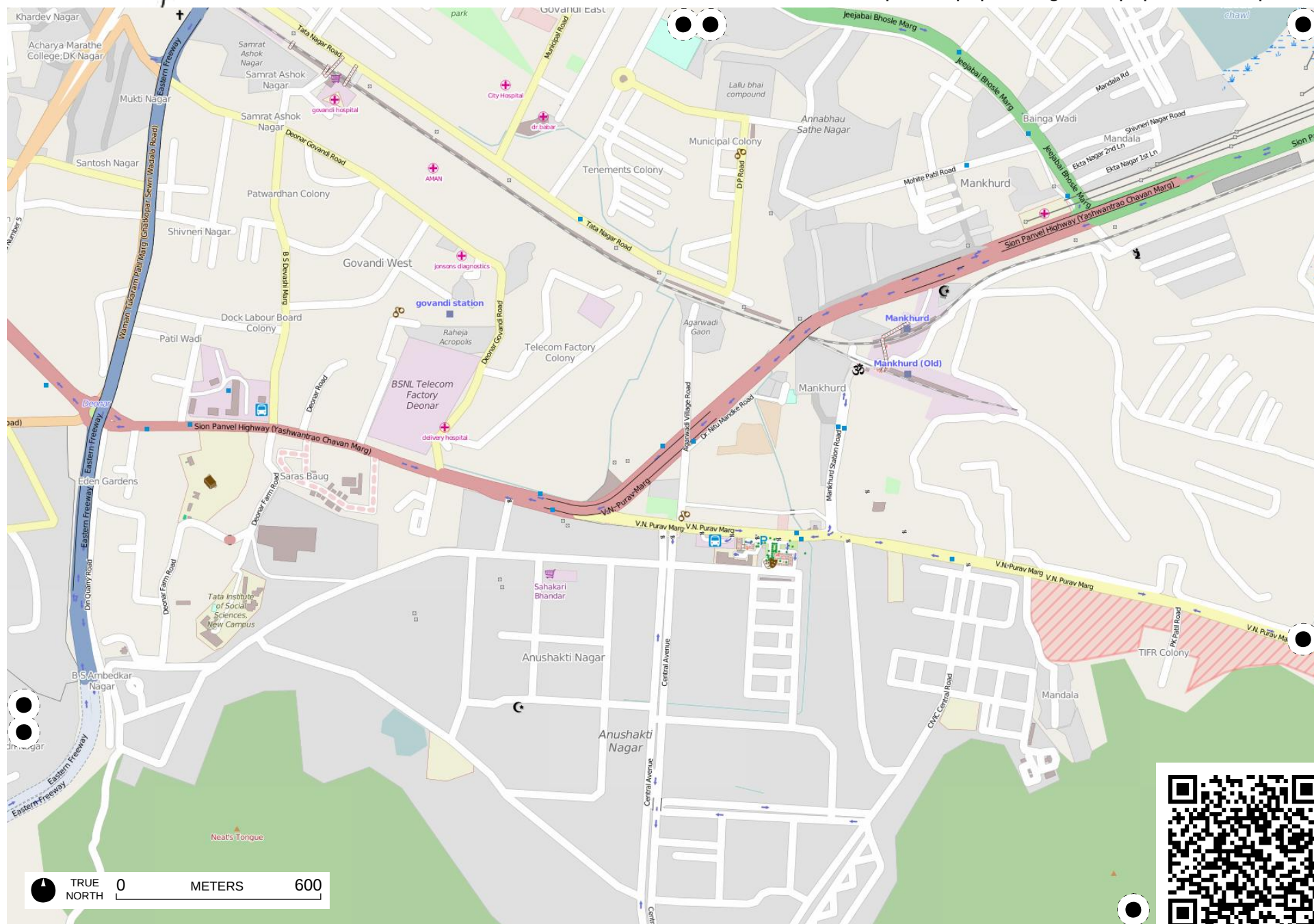
