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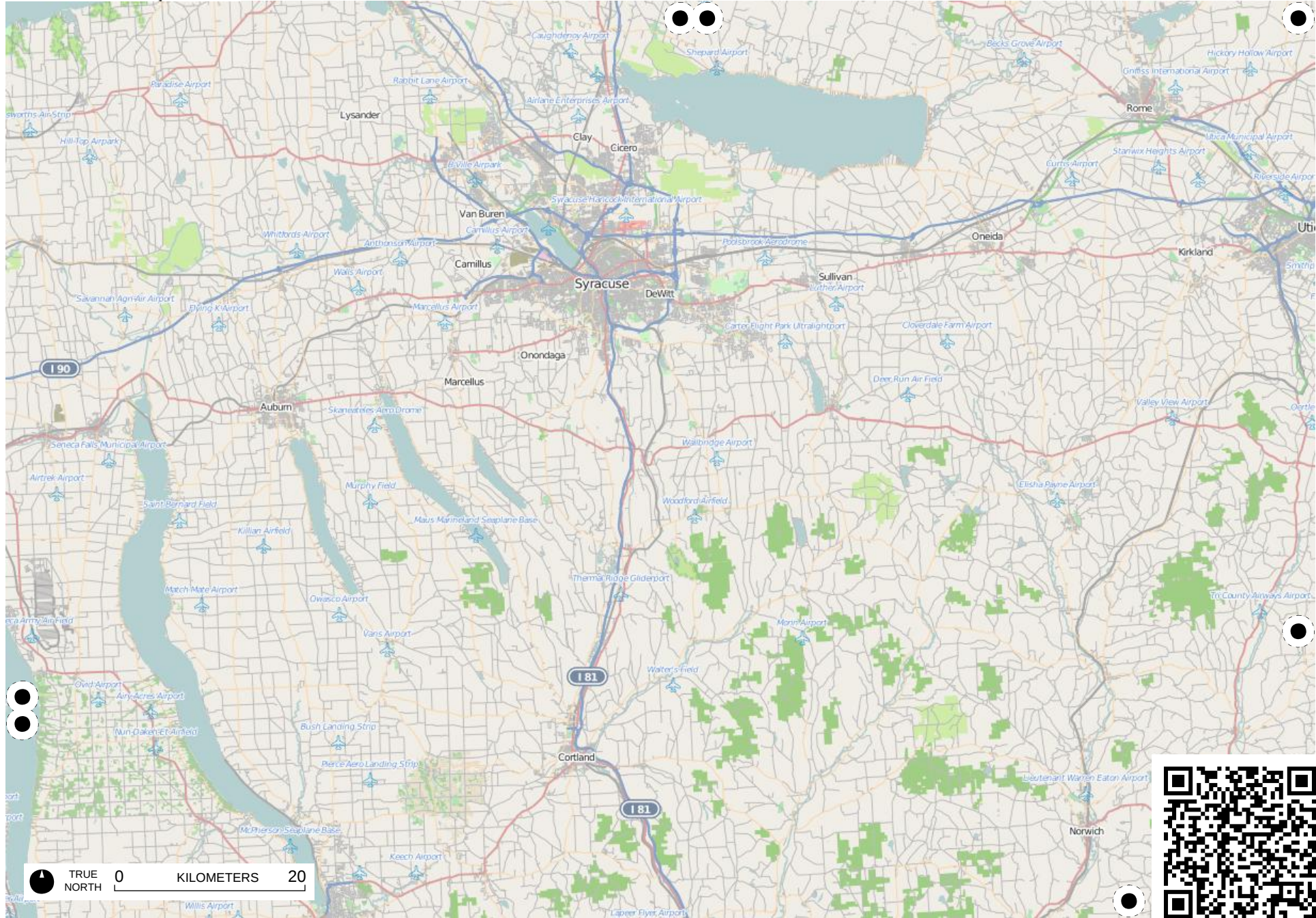


This map displays the Syracuse, New York metropolitan area and surrounding regions. Key features include:
