General Meeting Date – 10/25/2016

**Present –**

**1. Call to order** – The meeting was called to order by Tim at 7:07pm.

**2. Officers - President – Tim Hardy**

\*The board voted to add men’s and women’s lacrosse to the high school for the 2017 spring season. A budget was presented and approved. It was expressed that there is quite a large need for equipment to be able to hold home meets. The track is used by the middle school and high school.

\*The cross country team did well and were invited to the yearend meet at Cuthbertson. Tim mentioned that the booster club is checking into the possibility of having a cross country trail at Parkwood.

\*Tim stated that the Booster Club wants to make every sport successful.

\*Tim told the parents that the Booster Club had purchased a 100” reel mower for use by the high school and middle school to maintain the fields.

\*Tim mentioned that men’s volleyball will be a new sport to Union County next year and that the Booster Club will discuss the possibility of adding at Parkwood.
