

INTRODUCING GLYNDESTOCK

Quality real ale, great music, and a fun and friendly atmosphere in the open air. If this all sounds good to you then please read on as we think you'll enjoy our one day beer and music festival, which we are calling "Glyndestock".

To be held on Saturday 4th September from 1pm to 11pm this one day event is being held in the beer garden and grounds of The Trevor Arms in Glynde. We will have 13 real ales; five Harveys, and eight guest beers including brews from Dark Star, Hog's Back, Arundel, 1648, Skinners, Whites and Titanic. In addition, we're serving two draft ciders; one from Moles and one from Thatchers. The usual range of wines, lagers, spirits and soft drink will of course also be on offer.

Our live music headliners are the fantastic nine-piece Motown band, Big Wheels who will end the evening with a foot-stomping, hand-clapping two hour set from 9pm – 11pm. Prior to them we are proud to present The Fold, a Lewes based band playing Celtic Rock; the enigmatic Sam Chara who is based in Brighton and will be performing theatrical cabaret numbers in a voice that soothes you in one instant and the next can only be coming up from her boots it's that powerful! All thanks to her background as an award-winning classical soprano; Robert Brown, a superb folk/indie musician and his collection of weird and wonderful stringed instruments; Ahabe and The Wailer will get us into the groove of summer with their reggae and calypso tunes and Porchlight Smoker, an outstanding Brighton-based bluegrass band that you can not fail to enjoy - see if you can keep track of how many times the different instruments are passed around amongst this group of highly talented musicians! In between the live acts we have DJs spinning the sun-drenched sounds of Latin, Reggae, Soul, Funk,

Disco, Lounge, Jazz, Pop and no doubt some odd and interesting curiosities will also find their way onto the turntables.

To help soak up the beer and enable you to sample even more, there will be a food stall offering sandwiches, salads, burgers, hot-dogs, teas and coffees etc. There will also be a hog roast with all the trimmings of juicy crisp cracking and delicious sage and onion stuffing – practically a given for any self-respecting outdoor event!

As if this weren't enough, there's more! The day will include fete style stalls including tombola, a raffle, lucky dip, a professional psychic, face-painting and also commercial stalls selling a selection of hand-crafted goods. All in all it promises to be a fantastically fun day out and we hope to make it an established annual event so you can come again next year!

As well as coming along to join in the fun, you will also be supporting the four local beneficiaries of Glyndestock who are The Glynde and Beddingham Playgroup, Glynde Cricket Club, SPROUTS (a local organisation that works all year round to fund-raise for local charities) and Lewes Football Club.
