Denys Baptiste Quartet

Artist, composer and educator Denys Baptiste, a graduate of Tomorrow's Warriors is an outstanding saxophonist of international acclaim. A Mercury prize and Mobo award winner in 1999 with his first album, the following year saw him win the Rising Star Category in the BBC Jazz Awards. His third album Let Freedom Ring in 2003

was the Jazzwise magazine album of the year. This concert will be a live preview of the music as featured on his latest recording, Identity by Subtraction, with the CD expected to be released towards the end of this year. Pianist Andrew McCormack himself was a winner of the Rising Star Category in the 2006 BBC Jazz Awards, whilst Gary Crosby is of course the leader and inspiration behind both Tomorrow's Warriors and, with his partner Janine Irons, the driving force behind Dune Music. This all star quartet line-up is completed by American drummer Rod Youngs, born in Washington DC and now based in London.

Raised in South Africa, but now based in the UK, chromatic harmonica player Adam Glasser makes a welcome return to Watermill Jazz. His last visit in 2009 was viewed by our club chairman, Roger Hind, as one of the gigs of the year. The music reflects his upbringing in South Africa and the evening will include selected tracks from Adam's album Free

at First, which in April this year won a music award for best contemporary jazz album in his homeland. Joining Adam is the up and coming pianist Barry Green, along with Larry Bartley, who has become the most sought after bass players on the London jazz scene. Drummer Martin France last here with Kenny Wheeler, came to prominence in the 1980's with the big band Loose Tubes, which saw the start of a long musical association with both Django Bates and Iain Ballamy.
