SSAB (SSAB.ST) - Customers are accusing steel giants for antitrust violations

Six major U.S. customers have sued SSAB and seven other steel companies for antitrust violations. They are accused of having driven up steel prices over a four year period by restricting their production. SSAB expect the worst - a long and expensive battle in court in Chicago. The claim for damages against the steel giants could end up on billions of dollars. (Dagens industri, 13 April)

STOCKMANN (STCBV.HE) - Sales lift for Lindex

Cloth chain Lindex sales in March increased by 22.5 percent to EUR 44.2m, equivalent to SEK 430m. As in the previous month Lindex's sales increased in all market areas except in Latvia. (Dagens industri, 13 April)

PEAB (PEABb.ST) - Peab receives SEK 122m order from Tromsø

Peab Norwegian subsidiary Bear Construction has signed an agreement with Tromsø municipality for the reconstruction and extension of Tromstunskolan in Tromsø worth SEK 122m. The School should be ready in August 2011. (Dagens industri, 13 April)

SEADRILL (SDRL.OL) - Seadrill offers to buy remaining shares of Scorpion

Seadrill Ltd. offered to buy the remaining shares in Scorpion Offshore Ltd. after increasing its stake to 40.1 percent, triggering a mandatory bid for the offshore oil rig company. It didn't give a price for the offer, but a purchase at the same price it paid investors in the open market today would value the company at about 3.23 billion kroner (\$550 million). Seadrill will issue as many as 12.5 million shares to finance the acquisition and the possible purchase of a jack-up rig. The issue, which has been guaranteed by Seadrill's major shareholder Hemen Holding Ltd. and is expected to be completed before 9 a.m. local time on April 13, it said.
