Adastra Minerals Inc (formerly **America Mineral Fields Inc**), was a London-based mining company with notable operations in central Africa (Angola, Democratic Republic of Congo, and Zambia), particularly in copper, cobalt and zinc exploration. **Adastra's** properties and concessions were acquired in 2006 by First Quantum Minerals for \$245m in cash and stock, outpacing a counter-offer by Mwana Africa plc.

Notable personnel

- Jean-Raymond Boule, founder; owned 10% stake at time of acquisition by First Quantum.
