Students are welcome to help themselves to whatever they need, no questions asked. The Tiger Den often gives students boxes of non-perishable food items to take home.

**Chelsea's Boutique**, established as a tribute to Ivy's niece who passed away in 2007, has provided formal clothing for special events such as Homecoming, Prom, and the Military Ball.

The **Tiger Den** and **Chelsea's Boutique** are open every school day, on the Jones High School Campus, helping to provide students with the essentials needed for comfort and success. Hundreds of children have been served. They have been featured in the Orlando Sentinel, Channel 13 News-Orlando, NBC News Nightly with Brian Williams, Star 94.5, WFTV, and WOKB.
