report that on 5/25/10 I was dispatched to the C-town parking lot for a male wearing a diaper causing a disturbance. Dispatch stated the man was sitting in CT reg. 767ESZ, a 1990 Ford Bronco registered to a Thomas Wellington.

Upon arrival I located the vehicle and made contact with the male inside. He was identified as Thomas Wellington DOB 5/5/69 of 72 Vought Pl., Stratford. Thomas was covered in sweat and had spandex pants pulled up to his mid thigh area and a large diaper under the spandex. I asked Thomas what he was doing and he stated nothing. I asked if he approached a pedestrian asking for baby wipes and for them to wipe him. He said no. I asked why he had a diaper on and he said because he can't control his bowels. Thomas had a bulge in his pants and had baby pacifiers all over his vehicle. I asked Thomas again what he was doing in the parking lot and he still stated nothing.

I then made contact with the complainant who wanted to remain nameless. The complainant stated she was with her 3 grandchildren, ages 10, 8, and 9 months, when Thomas jumped out his car and stopped them in the parking lot. The complainant said Thomas was only wearing a large baby diaper and was sucking on a baby pacifier. She said Thomas then yelled to her "do you have baby wipes" and proceeded to ask several times if she could wipe him. The complainant ignored him and went to her vehicle and drove away. The complainant said she was afraid of the man and wanted to report it to police in fear that the man may try to harm a child. The complainant also stated that a number of people were in the parking lot and saw the commotion.

C-town is a retail establishment with numerous stores and a large parking lot. While on scene numerous people and children were in the area and stopped for the disturbance. Thomas was run through NCIC, PRAWN, III, and SPRC. He showed Due to Thomas's peculiar, boisterous behavior in a crowded public parking lot he was issued misdemeanor summons MB925934 charging him with 53a-181 Breach of Peace 2nd. He was given a court date of 6/4/10 and was released on a PTA.
