(The Brasserie has a taste of Italy with pizzas & pastas available for \$10)



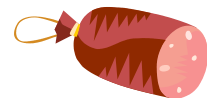

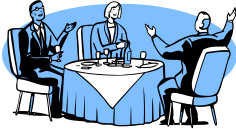
