PRESTON OF DRY CREEK 9282 West Dry Creek Road, Healdsburg

Lou Preston will share his thoughts and show his approach to farming sustainably in a viticultural context, including ecological and crop diversity, integration of animals, use of hedgerows, natural solutions to soil nutrition, pest and weed control. Bring your walking shoes.

Preston of Dry Creek is a 125-acre Certified Organic farm and winery, established by the Prestons in 1973. Lou and Susan raised their family here and thus eschewed chemical farming, but it wasn't until a decade ago that they began their conversion to holistic land stewardship. It's a work in progress; we'll also discuss future ideas and directions.

Ever wanted to get up close and personal with a century-old Zinfandel vine?

Join Ray and Lori Teldeschi for a walk among their 100+ year-old head-pruned Zinfandel vines. Ray Teldeschi Vineyards is located in eastern central Dry Creek Valley on benchland where the soil and the microclimate allow Ray to produce stellar quality fruit year after year.

During the vineyard tour, Ray will share stories of how he nurtures these ancient Zin vines. He'll explain why he—like his father before him—always uses sustainable farming practices that are good for both the vines and the folks who live nearby. Ray will also describe how pruning styles can produce better fruit.

Ray Teldeschi Vineyards provides grapes to many producers throughout Sonoma County, including Ray and Lori's own Del Carlo wines. Del Carlo's '06 Old Vine Zinfandel recently scored 91points and was named one of the Year's Best Zinfandels in Wine & Spirits Magazine.

Enjoy a morning in the vineyards, learn a bit more about viticulture practices and enhance your appreciation for exceptional old vine Zinfandel.

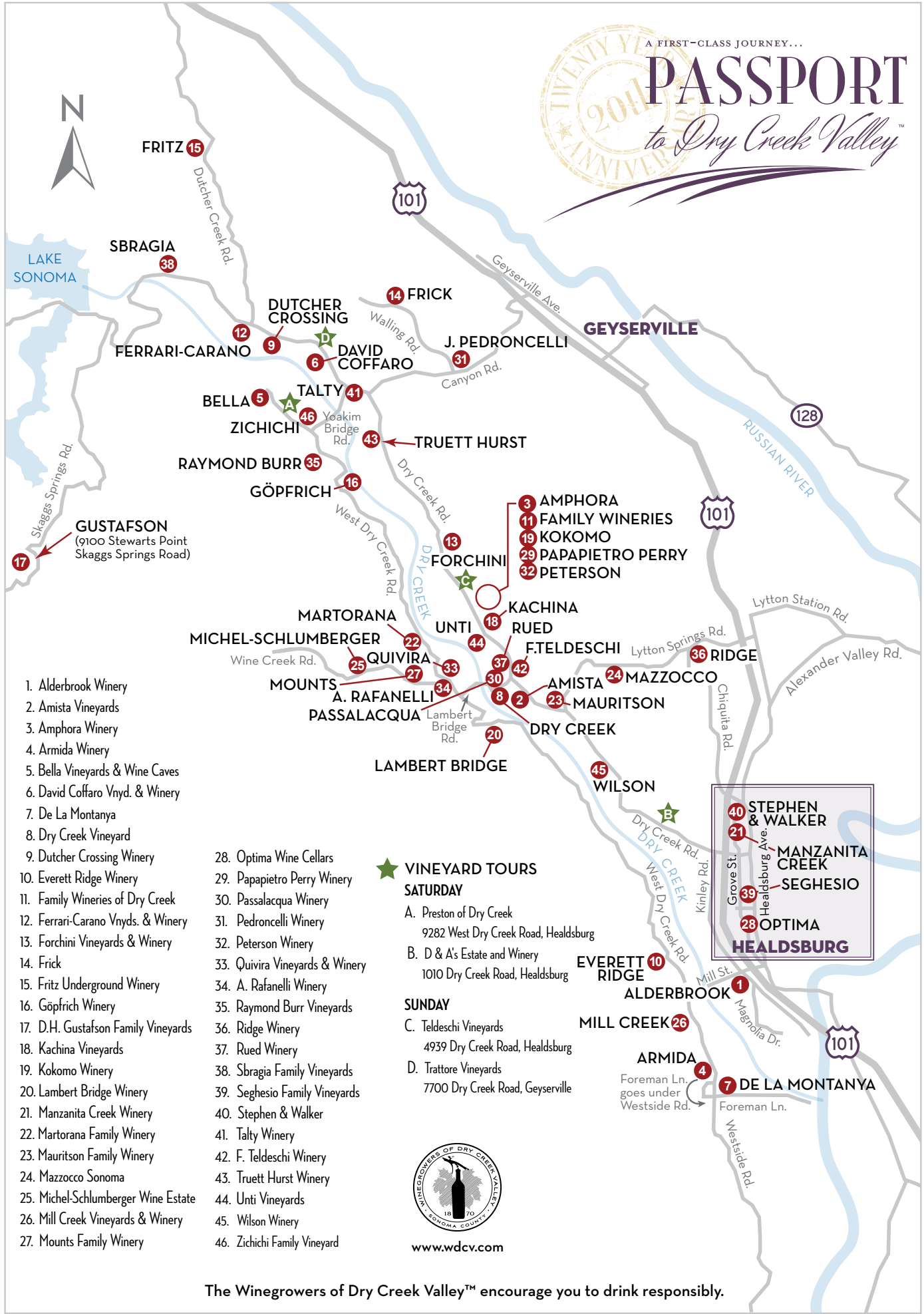

Buses and Limos. Not all wineries can accommodate small buses and limousines. Please check individual winery listing for restrictions. When making plans for Passport, please be aware that large, full-size buses will not be allowed at this event. Receiving a group of 40-60 people at one time is increasingly difficult on our wineries. To be responsible hosts, to provide an experience worth remembering, and to adequately describe the variety of wines being poured, smaller groups of people are ideal. Therefore smaller buses and limousines will be allowed at Passport. We encourage you to drink responsibly and make arrangements for limos, or small limo buses if necessary.

Drive Carefully. Please drive carefully. The roads are narrow and there is a lot of traffic during Passport weekend. Please be advised that California Highway Patrol will be in the Valley to enforce parking restrictions.

Ease of Travel. In order to ease the crowds and lessen congestion we strongly suggest that you begin your Passport adventure in the area of the winery at which you are assigned to begin. For instance, if you are assigned to pick up your Passports Saturday at Mill Creek Winery in the southern end of the valley, plan on visiting Armida, Alderbrook, Everett Ridge, Seghesio, etc. on Saturday. On Sunday, head to the north end of the valley. Or if you are slated to start at Fritz on Saturday, stay in the north end on Saturday and visit the southern end on Sunday.
