Dear brothers and sisters, this information is an addition to what has been written already about Valeriy and Julie Kachuk. This information will help you to get to know us as a family better and will help you to have a better view about the Lord's work in this wonderful country Ukraine.

We would like to thank all of you for being so generous to us, for showing your care, prayers, kindness, comfort, encouragements, lots of help and love to us. Paul is addressing the following to us and to you my friends: *"I **thank** my **God** always, making mention of you in my prayers, because I hear of your **love** and of the **faith** which you have toward the Lord Jesus and toward all the saints; and I pray that the fellowship of your **faith** may become **effective** through the **knowledge** of every **good thing** which is in you for **Christ** sake. For I have come to have much **joy** and **comfort** in your **love**, because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed through you, brother."* [1] Wouldn't you be glad when people talking about you with the same gratitude and proper attitude in their words? Paul did. Even though the Church was under persecution with lots of problems in it, still the Church was growing in the 1<sup>st</sup> century. The Good News was spreading rapidly. Even though their life style was a lot more difficult then ours Paul still maintained and managed his attitude in the Lord.

I want to encourage us brothers and sisters with such words: God is Great, God is Awesome and God is Almighty! God is Omniscient, Omnipotent and Omnipresent! He loves us all and disciplines at the same time. Both Julie and I are happy to know that our names are written in His book of life along with your names too.

Julie and I are simple **servants** and simple **Christians** in this wonderful country Ukraine. We worked in Kramatorsk for 5 years. We helped the Church to increase the youth group out of two we've grown up to twenty young teenagers. Right now for 2010 12-15 remains still over there and some became fathers already. Ha! Those whom I baptized three to five to my knowledge are in BVBID extension institute in Gorlovka receiving theology education.

Also Kachuk's family has been working for the last 8 years with WWYC and EEM organizations during the summer time. For us it was a great privilege to help the orphan kids and kids with families to get to know the Love of Jesus from the Bible. Ukrainians are very open with their hearts of welcoming people from the West to teach their kids about Christ's love. *"**Train up a child in the way he should go, even when he is old he **will not depart** from it.**"* [2] We have been planting seeds in the hearts of these kids for last 8 years. This is a great influence, privilege, and a blessing for every child to hear the love stories in the summer camp. It is also a great privilege and a blessing for us to share those wonderful love stories with the kids. Each summer we work with the amount of 400-500 children just in one camp and another one is about 60-80 kids.

Kharkov is a wonderful city where we live and work as missionaries now. God is a Great! We are hoping He will bless us for His work in this wonderful city. We do have a great spiritual support group not only from the Churches around us but also with some missionary couples who moved to Kharkov from US to help us in our mutual work. Julie and I live in the area 'Novye Doma' of 400,000 people where the Church of Christ just has started to gather together at our place on Sundays along with other places in down town. Soon Kachuk's family will be doing campaign on our own initiative in the area where we live and start evangelizing it. We are blessed to have such wonderful people around us. And we are blessed to know that we are in your prayers as well.

Julie and I would like to add up pictures to this letter that will explain and show the work that has already been done in the Ukraine for Kachuk's family. It is not our work it is the Lord's work. All praise to God and Honor and Glory to Him. We are simple **tools** who do the job of the missionaries, evangelists and simple servants who help people to go to Heaven and be with the Lord.

Thank you so much brothers and sister for taking into consideration our letters including this additional letter. Your partnership and involvement into this work is very important. Thank you so much dear brothers and sisters for coming into former Soviet Union countries preaching the Word of Jesus and spreading the Good News.
