

General Information about Story Book Lodge Christian Camp

Registration

When you come to Story Book, please register at the camp office between the hours of 3:30 and 5:30 pm on the Sunday when your particular camp session begins. The first official event of your camp program is supper at 5:30 pm followed by a campfire at 8 pm.

Physicals

A health form is attached which needs to be completed in full and signed by your parent/guardian. Be sure to bring this form with you when you come for registration. If your child needs any type of professional medical attention while at Story Book, your insurance will be responsible for the cost. If you have no insurance, the camp insurance will go into effect for your child.

Cabin Assignments

When you registered for camp, you were given the option of listing **ONE** special friend to be with you in your cabin. If you listed more than one friend, the first friend listed is the one used for cabin placement. (In the past we have tried to honor camper requests for multiple friends, but it became too complicated). Cabin assignments are made by the camp director factoring in your age and the cabin counselor. At registration, you will be told which cabin is yours.

Cancellations

If you cannot come, please call us and cancel even if it is at the last minute. For most of our camps we have a waiting list, so please do not substitute another person in your place.
