

## Guidelines For Kitchen Staff Helpers

Please try to be available & ready to prepare Sunday evening meal the first day of camp. If you cannot be here by 4:30 pm, please notify Roxanne. Most head cooks have a planning time to prepare for the coming week right after the Sunday evening meal.

The state health department requires that you:

- Always wash your hands before handling food. Also, after eating, you need to wash your hands before putting away food.
- Always wear a scarf or hair net while working with food.
- Use plastic gloves when handling food that will not be cooked.

For the benefit of all those who work in the kitchen please:

- Check with the head cook to see what time to be in the kitchen each morning.
- Do not leave the kitchen until you have checked with the head cook to make sure nothing else needs to be done at that time.
- After each meal put away leftovers, wash off the counters & check with the head cook about beginning prep work for the next meal.
- If you have family or friends visit, please ask them to come out in the evening, or during a break you may have in the afternoon.
- Do not invite other children as guests if you have pre-camp age children with you.
- If you have to leave camp during the day, please check with the head cook about the most convenient time.
- If you are unsure of what needs to be done or how to help, please ask the head cook & don't wait to be asked.

If you are unable to give a full week, check with Roxanne as another week might be more helpful to the camp.

Before you leave camp, please make sure your living unit is clean & ready for the next party.
