WHAT WILL YOU STUDY?

This full time, 26 week programme (excluding holidays) is designed to prepare you to enter the construction industry..

The programme has the support of SARNZ (Scaffolding and Rigging New Zealand) and SRIRIT (Scaffolding and Rigging Industrial Rope Industry Training) and is recognised by employers as a preferred means of entering this industry.

This programme is unit standard based and covers:

- practical use of hand tools
- lifting equipment use
- working with cranes
- height safety
- erection scaffolding
- rigging work
- safe use of EWP
- associated track calculation
- healthy and safety requirements for the height access industry

Upon successful completion of the programme, you will gain the Certificate in Pre - Trade Height Access, The VAT Certificate in pre trade Rigging (level 3) (62 credits) as well as a number of unit standards towards National Certificates in Rigging Rope Access and Scaffolding.



Work Experience

As part of your programme, you will be expected to spend time on construction sites working with experienced industry professionals.

This will be your chance to prove your worth to the industry.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Certificate in Pre-Trade Height Access

- Applicants must be a minimum of 16 years of age
- Applicants must have successfully completed NCEA Level One or equivalent, or: hold Communication Skills Level 2; or be able to demonstrate sound written and oral skills; or have completed a local or National Certificate in the Construction Industry or a related field
- Applicants for whom English is a second language must meet IELTS (or equivalent) Level 5.5 or above.
- Physical strength, balance, coordination and motor skills all need to be unimpaired to work within this industry for safety reasons.

Selection Criteria

If the programme is oversubscribed applications will be processed in the order received.

National Certificate in Rigging

- Basic Strand (Level 3)
- Intermediate Strand (Level 3)
- Advanced Strand (Level 4)

Entry is open. However, physical strengths, dexterity, balance, co-ordination and motor skills all need to be unimpaired to work within this industry, for safety reasons.
