Rotary annually honors a Lincoln University student with a scholarship based on need, academic achievement and dedication to service.

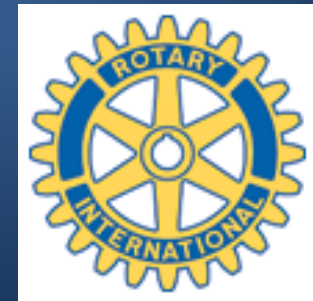

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q** When was the first Rotary Club in Jefferson City Missouri founded?

**A** The Rotary Club of Jefferson City was founded in 1918. Today the Rotary Club of Jefferson City is one of five clubs including the West Club, Breakfast Club, Evening Club and Rotaract Club.

**Q** How much does it cost annually to be a member of the Rotary Club of Jefferson City?

**A** Membership dues are \$60 per quarter. Members are also encouraged to contribute to the Rotary's international and local foundations and to assist in efforts to eradicate polio worldwide.

**Q** Does the Rotary Club of Jefferson City have attendance requirements?

**A** The Rotary Club of Jefferson City strives for excellent attendance and recognizes that members must occasionally miss meetings. Rotary has a procedure in which members can attend another club's meeting to *make up* a meeting.

**Q** How many clubs and members does Rotary have worldwide?

**A** Our local club is a member of a worldwide fraternity of more than 33,000 Rotary clubs in 200 countries with over 1.2 million members. Rotary is best known for its efforts eradicating polio throughout the world and is actively involved in many humanitarian efforts.
