Dear Sir,

We acknowledge receipt of your unsigned letter dated 29 August 2011, addressed to the FIFA Ethics Committee, regarding Mr Chuck Blazer.

In this context, we would like to refer you to art. 16 of the FIFA Code of Ethics which establishes that "FIFA accepts complaints only from the Executive Committee of an association, the Executive Committee of a confederation, members of the FIFA Executive Committee and from the FIFA Secretary General".

In this regard, we kindly inform you that, to date, the FIFA Ethics Committee did not receive any complaint from one of the above-mentioned bodies in connection with the alleged facts reported in your aforementioned correspondence. Furthermore, up to the present, FIFA did not receive any sufficiently corroborating evidence which would allow opening proceedings in connection with the alleged facts.

In view of all of the above, no ethics proceedings have been initiated against Mr Chuck Blazer.
