



MARINER'S SCARF

Finished Size: approximately 8 x 39 inches

Cast on 40 stitches.*
K 8 rows (garter stitch).

Work pattern as follows:

Rows 1 - 6: K2, (K6, P6) 3 times; K2.
Rows 7 and 8: K across.
Row 9 - 14: K2, (P6, K6) 3 times, K2.
Rows 15 and 16: K across.
Repeat rows 1 – 16 for checkerboard pattern.
(Note that you will be alternating a knit block above a purl block.)

Continue in pattern until you have about 39 inches, ending with either a 6th or 14th row.

K 8 rows (Garter stitch) and bind off.

Do not block scarf.

*If your gauge is too large, cast on 12 fewer stitches. If your gauge is too small, cast on 12 more stitches. Your checkerboard pattern will likewise increase or decrease by one repeat.

ABOUT THIS PATTERN

Our classic basketweave pattern is a great choice for river mariners, and it pairs nicely with Oliver's Cap.

MATERIALS

Approx. 300 yds. worsted weight yarn

US size 7 needles
(or size needed to achieve gauge)

GAUGE

4.5 sts and 6 rows=1 inch
