

John R. Balmes, M.D.

Member of California Air Resources Board
Professor of Medicine at UCSF
Professor of Environmental Health Sciences at U Berkeley
Chief of the Division of Occupational and Environmental
Medicine at SFGH

Dr. Balmes has a laboratory called the Human
Exposure Laboratory. There he has been studying
respiratory and cardiovascular health for over 25 years.
His laboratory was the first to show:

- histological evidence of ozone-induced airway injury
and inflammation in human subjects
- asthmatic subjects have more inflammatory responses to
ozone than normal subjects
- asthmatic subjects recruit macrophages to the airways
with consecutive day exposures
- exposure to secondhand tobacco smoke causes
endothelial dysfunction

Dr. Balmes has written over 200 papers and chapters on
occupational and environmental
respiratory disease related problems. Consequences of air
pollution on health is the focus of his work. He is board-
certified for Internal Medicine and Pulmonary Medicine.
