Dear brothers and sisters, I would like to start with Jesus' words: *"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt has become tasteless, how can it be made salty {again?} It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled under foot by men." 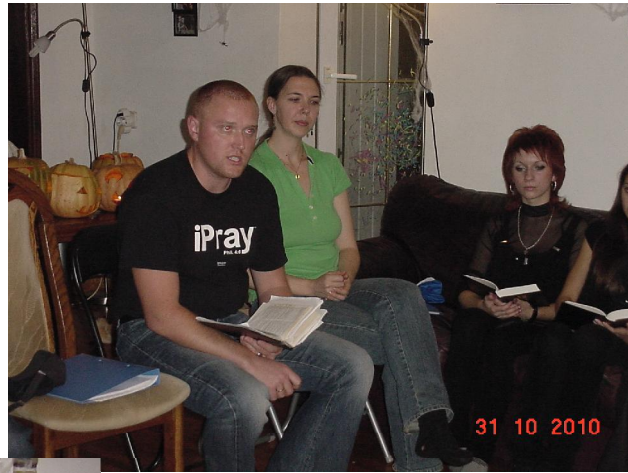

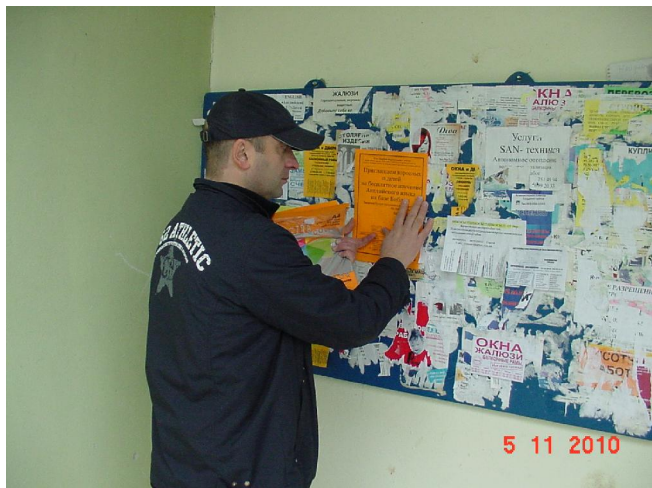
Thank you so much for providing me with extra support for the tickets to Russia.

Alexeevka is another area of Kharkov where I am involved in evangelism program that used to work very well one year ago. Again I am going to use this method of teaching new comers of the Gospel but using Bible in English as our text. I will be responsible for three classes per week: Monday night, Wednesday night and Saturday afternoon. It is a free course for adults to come as well as children. I do have materials songs, lessons, and video to make it interactive and interesting. We are hoping by the end of this year to have 5-10 people studying Bible at this program. Yesterday in the Church I and Valeriy preacher did announcements about this classes. First week I will register all new comers and later on we will change time if necessary and days we are flexible. Alexeevka is an area of 250.000 people so we need lost of prayers for this people and for the Church to grow in this area too. Thank you for all your prayers dear brothers and sisters. By the way, it is going to be done on the regular bases I mean inviting people and fellowshiping with them outside the Church building.

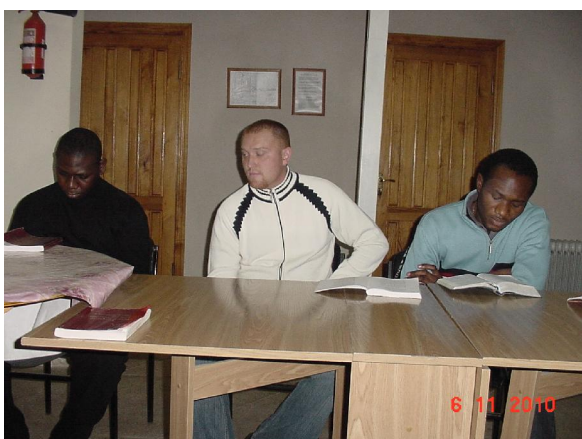
