All our adult courses run for a duration of 6 weeks. Attendance is ONCE A WEEK. All lessons are 1.5 hours long except for the first lesson of Course 1, which is 2 hours long.

PAYMENT: The cost for individuals attending Course 1 at our language school in Upper Woodstock is R1250. If the full amount is paid upfront on or before lesson 1, then it is reduced to R1200. If you need to pay in installments, we request a non-refundable payment of R450 by lesson 1 and the balance of R800 by lesson 5. Please pay via cash or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT). The cost of the course includes tuition by qualified, well experienced instructors and the following materials:

COURSE 1 – Essential Social Xhosa (R1250 or R1200 if paid in full by lesson 1)

This course is carefully paced so that by week 6 you are able to have a full conversation, from greetings and introductions to small talk and farewells.

COURSE 2 – Essential Practical Xhosa (R1250 or R1200 if paid in full by lesson 1)

This course equips you with language for everyday themes and situations including the weather, at the garage and shops, hospitality etc.

COURSE 3 – Essential Health and Workplace Xhosa (R1250 or R1200 if paid in full by lesson 1)

This course builds on general topics including locating things (on top of, behind, below etc.), the body and health, feelings and language for discussions and meetings.

GRAMMAR COURSES: (R1250. This includes the purchase of Alexandra Byant's book titled Xhosa for Second-Language Learners. If you have the book already, the course will cost you R980.) Our grammar courses are a wonderful resource for people who either need, or just enjoy, a deeper knowledge of how the Xhosa language is structured. As with all our short courses, attendance is an hour and a half per week, for 6 weeks.

XHOSA FOR KIDS (3 – 9 year olds) These Saturday morning workshops are filled with fun activities including stories, action songs and games for children to enjoy while learning Xhosa. It is pure 'edutainment'!

COURSE 1 – Essential Social Xhosa Entry requirements: Understanding of English.

The **COURSE 1 START DATES** and class times are below. Classes run at the time specified, weekly, for 6 consecutive weeks. Lesson 1 is 2 hours long and thereafter classes are 1.5 hours long.
