- That all 5 of the Hochstedler children are healthy and growing
- For the completion of their school year (which was a little late due to baby Lucas' arrival)
- That God has raised up a strong Christian lady to assume the leadership at their residential home as well as the funds to pay her
- For lasting fruit from the work done in evangelism and child protection by friends of theirs during the Olympics
- For two weeks (late August/early September), their team was involved with 4 different training opportunities with about 600 people. These were primarily social work/foster care related, but the hope is that the light of Christ was evident to the trainees and will ultimately bear Kingdom fruit.
- For a maintenance man for their Casa Elohim property which is showing signs of wear and tear. 6-12 months of such help would turn the tide.
- For funding partners for the foster care program for next year because the government funds are going to end.
- For more foster families willing to take children, such as the recent hospitalized 3 month old whose health is critical due to negligence.


Childcare Position available
