

**Daily Peace Scriptures for December 1-25, 2018**  
*Pray These Scriptures for PEACE in Every Heart and Home*

- Dec. 1** - Luke 2:13- Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, 'Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests.'"
- Dec. 2** - Isaiah 9:6-7a For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
- Dec. 3** - Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.
- Dec. 4** - Col. 3:15 Let the peace of Christ RULE in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace.
- Dec. 5** - Jn. 14:27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
- Dec. 6** - Jn. 16:33 Jesus' Peace is different than what the world gives – <sup>33</sup>"I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."
- Dec. 7** - Phil. 4:6-7 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. <sup>7</sup> And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.
- Dec. 8** - Ephes. 6:13-15 Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.
- Dec. 9** - Numbers 6:24-26 The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make his face shine on you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn his face toward you and give you peace.'"
- Dec. 10** - Judges 6:22-24 When Gideon realized that it was the angel of the Lord, he exclaimed, "Alas, Sovereign Lord! I have seen the angel of the Lord face to face!"  
But the Lord said to him, "Peace! Do not be afraid. You are not going to die."  
So Gideon built an altar to the Lord there and called it The Lord Is Peace (*shalom*).
- Dec. 11** - Psalm 34:14 Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.
- Dec. 12** - Psalm 85:8 I will listen to what God the LORD says; he promises peace to his people, his faithful servants—but let them not turn to folly.
- Dec. 13** - Proverbs 14:30 A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones.
- Dec. 14** - Proverbs 17:1 Better a dry crust with peace and quiet than a house full of feasting, with strife.
- Dec. 15** - Isaiah 26:3 You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you.
- Dec. 16** - Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"
- Dec. 17** - Isaiah 53:5 But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed.
- Dec. 18** - Isaiah 54:10 Though the mountains be shaken and the hills be removed, yet my unfailing love for you will not be shaken nor my covenant of peace be removed," says the Lord, who has compassion on you.

**Dec. 19** - Isaiah 55:12 You will go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and hills will burst into song before you, and all the trees of the field will clap their hands.

**Dec. 20** - Luke 10:5 "When you enter a house, first say, 'Peace to this house.' " If someone who promotes peace is there, your peace will rest on them; if not, it will return to you.

**Dec. 21** - Romans 12:18 If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.

**Dec. 22** - Romans 15:13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

**Dec. 23** - Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self control.

**Dec. 24** - James 3:17-18 But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness.

**Dec. 25** - 1 Peter 3:11 They must turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.

### **Serenity Prayer**

God grant me the serenity, to accept the things I cannot change;  
the courage to change the things I can; and wisdom to know the difference.

Living one day at a time; enjoying one moment at a time;  
accepting hardships as the pathway to peace;
