News from Dave Broadwell - Jesus Film Project

The Broadwells enjoyed a wonderful Christmas, getting to spend a few days with family and simply having the five of them (Dave, Susan, Hannah, Naomi, and Samuel) in one place at the same time. It has also been encouraging to reflect on what the Lord has done through Jesus Film Mission Trips over the past year. They thank God that in 2018, Jesus Film Mission Trips sent out 40 groups around the world through which 3,893 people indicated they desired to follow Jesus. They were also able to see 2,354 believers trained in evangelism.

Dave began the year with a retreat for his staff to help them connect relationally with one another. It was great to get away and have undistracted time in the Word together. Their first trip of the year left immediately after the retreat, as a group of 16 went to Panama to participate in World Youth Day. Many people were trained to share their faith and many others actually came to faith in Christ during this unique event with people from all over the world.

The Broadwell family is leading a trip to Mauritius in the Indian Ocean this summer (July 16-30). They would really love it if supporters would consider joining them. They provide the needed training, and it would be an amazing opportunity to show supporters what they do all around the world.


