- Ethiopian jam and dance band that plays a fusion of Ethiopian pentatonic scales and American funk and soul, using an intriguing blend of instruments, including accordion, violin, brass and drums. The group is performing with Fendika, which features a female vocalist, a dance

duo and a goat-skin drummer.

- Delhi 2 Dublin, at 1 p.m., combines traditional Celtic with Indian Bhangra, with touches of reggae and electronica. The band is based in Vancouver, British Columbia.
- Meklit Hadero, at 2:30 p.m., is an Ethiopian-born singer-songwriter who now lives in San Francisco.
- La Excelencia, at 4 p.m., is a dynamic 12-piece ensemble that plays hard salsa, combining musical styles and rhythms of Cuba, Puerto Rico and South America.
