Cooking With Kathi:

Strawberry Shortcake Poke Cake

This Strawberry Shortcake Poke Cake is a delicious, cool treat topped with a cream cheese and whipped cream frosting and all topped with fresh strawberries.

Recipe type: Dessert

Cuisine: American

Serves: 16-20

Ingredients

- **Yellow cake mix (plus ingredients on back)**
- **1 small box instant strawberry jell-o**
- **1 cup hot water**
- **1 cup cold water**
- **1 block (8oz) cream cheese (softened)**
- **1 tsp. vanilla**
- **1/2 cup powdered sugar**
- **2 cups Cool Whip**
- **2 pints Strawberries (sliced or chopped)**

Instructions

- 1. Make Yellow Cake mix by following directions on box.**
- 2. Once the cake is out, take a fork and poke it all over.**
- 3. While cake is still warm, make jell-o by adding mix to 1 cup hot water and dissolving and then adding 1 cup cold water. Spoon this liquid over the top of the cake, making sure it goes through the holes made by the fork.**
- 4. Refrigerate for 4 hours.**
- 5. When ready to serve make frosting by mixing cream cheese, and powdered sugar in a medium bowl. Add vanilla. Mix to well combine. Fold in Cool Whip. Spread over Cake.**
- 6. Spread sliced strawberries over the frosting or add to each square.**

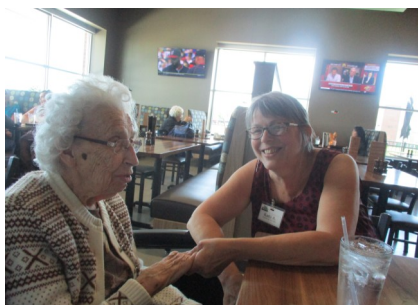
Dedicate a flag to Honor an American that is living or deceased.
