Cooking With Kathi:

Strawberry Shortcake Poke Cake

This Strawberry Shortcake Poke Cake is a delicious, cool treat topped with a cream cheese and whipped cream frosting and all topped with fresh strawberries.

Recipe type: Dessert Cuisine: American

Serves: 16-20

Ingredients

Yellow cake mix (plus ingredients on back)

- 1 small box instant strawberry jell-o
- 1 cup hot water
- 1 cup cold water
- 1 block (8oz) cream cheese (softened)
- 1 tsp. vanilla
- 1/2 cup powdered sugar
- 2 cups Cool Whip
- 2 pints Strawberries (sliced or chopped)

Instructions

- 1. Make Yellow Cake mix by following directions on box.
- 2. Once the cake is out, take a fork and poke it all over.
- 3. While cake is still warm, make jell-o by adding mix to 1 cup hot water and dissolving and then adding 1 cup cold water. Sppon this liquid over the top of the cake, making sure it goes through the holes made by the fork.
- 4. Refrigerate for 4 hours.
- 5. When ready to serve make frosting by mixing cream cheese, and powdered sugar in a medium bowl. Add vanilla. Mix to well combine. Fold in Cool Whip. Spread over Cake.
- 6. Spread sliced strawberries over the frosting or add to each square.
