Glenn Gray

Inducted: 2008

Starting in 1941 at the age of fifteen, Glenn was the Alberta Junior Champion for three consecutive years and followed that with Alberta Amateur victories in 1949 and 1952.

In the late 1940s and throughout the 1950s, Glenn was one of Alberta's leading amateurs making the Alberta Willingdon Cup team seven times.

Glenn's passion for golf extended beyond that of just being a player as he dedicated himself to leading junior golf programs while a member at the Royal Mayfair Golf and Country Club and as a board member of the Alberta Golf Association, of which he was elected president in 1968. Many of the junior

interprovincial and international tournaments that are still played today in a variety of forms were pioneered by Gray.

- *In 1940, at the tender age of fourteen, Glenn played in his first Canadian Junior and Juvenile Championship at the St. Bruno Golf Club in Montreal after travelling alone by train across Canada.*
