



## **MENS AMATEUR REGIONAL QUALIFYING FACT SHEET**

### **ABOUT THE REGIONAL QUALIFIERS**

Regional qualifiers serve as an entry point into The Sun Life Financial Alberta Mens Amateur Championship, which is the provinces premier golf event. The championship brings together 120 of the best players in the province.

- The regional qualifier is 18 holes of stroke-play competition.
- Ties for the final qualifying positions are broken by sudden-death playoff.

### **ENTRY FORM and ELIGIBILITY**

The entry deadline is **May 13, 2019**. The competition is open to male amateur golfers with a Handicap Factor of 8.0 or less, who are members in good standing of their provincial and/or state golf associations. The entry fee for the qualifier is **\$95**.

### **REGIONAL QUALIFYING SITES**

Regional Qualifier Calgary – Elbow Springs Golf Club, Calgary, AB – May 21<sup>st</sup>

Regional Qualifier Central – Ponoka Community Golf Club, Ponoka, AB – May 28<sup>th</sup>

Regional Qualifier Edmonton – Sturgeon Valley G&CC, Sturgeon County, AB – May 29<sup>th</sup>

Regional Qualifier South – Turner Valley Golf Club, Turner Valley, AB – June 17<sup>th</sup>

Regional Qualifier North – Grande Prairie G&CC, Grande Prairie, AB – June 23<sup>rd</sup>

### **REGISTRATION**

All competitors must register in-person with Alberta Golf prior to the start of the qualifier. Registration will be available near the pro-shop or in the clubhouse one hour prior to the first tee-time or shotgun. Important tournament information including local rules and competitor policies will be distributed at registration. Look for the registration sign.

### **QUALIFYING SPOTS**

The number of spots available at each site will be available at registration and it is based on the number of total spots available in the championship and the number of players registered at each site. Players will be notified if they have qualified once all of the scores have been returned. Players will be automatically entered into the championship at that point.

### **STARTING TIMES**

Starting times will be available online and emailed to all players at least five (5) days in advance and scheduled to allow for adequate travel and preparation time.

**CADDIES**

Players are allowed to bring their own caddie. Caddies must register at the starters tent each day to receive an official Alberta Golf caddie bib.

**PRACTICE FACILITIES**

Practice facilities will be available to all players on the qualifier date. Balls are complimentary, courtesy of the host club and Alberta Golf.

**COURSE SET-UP**

The competition will be from a maximum distance of 7,000 yards.
