Thank you for your March 14, 2007 gift of \$336.45 to Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF). **We are pleased to welcome you as a Doctors Without Borders Partner.** With your support, MSF is responding faster to emergencies and improving the quality and effectiveness of the medical care we provide in more than 70 countries around the world.

**Outbreak of Cholera in Angola:** Responding to a cholera outbreak which began in April 2006, Doctors Without Borders was able to treat more than 26,000 patients across eight of Angola's provinces. Our teams immediately rehydrated infected patients, isolated them with designated medical teams, and chlorinated water to stem the outbreak's spread.

**Darfur Refugees:** In response to the humanitarian crisis in the Darfur region of Sudan, Doctors Without Borders/MSF teams are providing surgical care, health services for displaced people, treatment for survivors of sexual violence and nutritional support for people in the region. MSF currently has over 2,000 staff working in 17 locations throughout Darfur.

**Essential Surgery for Iraqis:** The number of casualties in Iraq is escalating with the level of violence, and rampant insecurity, blackouts, and the threat of attacks makes it difficult to deliver specialized surgical care. Doctors Without Borders/MSF, in close coordination with a dedicated group of Iraqi surgeons, has opened a surgical program in Amman, Jordan, to provide essential reconstructive surgery for injured civilians.

Each and every day our volunteers use their skills and commitment to bring medical care to those who desperately need it. With your help as a Partner, we are able to treat more people. Thank you again for your generosity.
