Lesson 1: Walking in the Light—1 John 1:5-2:2

- **I.** The Principle: Our sharing relationship is with a holy God who is void of any sin in His character—1 John 1:5.
- **II.** The Principle Applied: The conditions for experiencing fellowship with the Lord are clearly set forth—1 John 1:6–2:2.
 - **A.** We walk with Him transparently, with an absence of hypocrisy—1 John 1:6.
 - **B.** We walk with Him honestly under His careful scrutiny in order to experience fellowship with Him—1 John 1:7.
 - **C.** If we deny our sinfulness His truth is not operating within us—1 John 1:8.
 - D. If we agree with the Lord about sins, we receive familial forgiveness for all of our sins—1 John 1:9.
 - **E.** If we deny specific sins, we demonstrate that His Word is not effectively working in us—1 John 1:10.
 - **F.** As those called to not sin, we have one who pleads our case—1 John 2:1.
 - **G.** Our confidence in this walk of fellowship rests in the truth that the Lord is fully satisfied with Christ's work on the cross on our behalf and on behalf of the entire world—

 1 John 2:2.
