Lesson 10: Responding in Prayer—Nehemiah 9:1–38

- Preparation to praise and worship: The people grieved over their sins in light of the truth of the Law—Nehemiah 9:1-4.
 - **A.** The people mourned over their sinfulness—Nehemiah 9:1–2.
 - **B.** The people read the Law and confessed their sins—Nehemiah 9:3–4.
- II. Remembering God's great work: The people recounted the work of God on their behalf— Nehemiah 9:5–15.
 - **A.** They honored the name of the Lord, the God of creation—*Nehemiah 9:5–6*.
 - **B.** They praised the Lord for establishing the covenant with Abraham—Nehemiah 9:7–8.
 - **C.** They praised Him for delivering them from bondage in Egypt and leading them through the wilderness—*Nehemiah* 9:9–12.
 - **D.** They honored the Lord for providing His law and providing them manna—*Nehemiah 9:13–15.*
- **III.** Recounting their sins: The people listed how they had failed to obey the Lord and how He had shown His loyal love to them—*Nehemiah* 9:16–31.
 - **A.** The Lord remained gracious and merciful and provided for the nation during their rebellion in wilderness—*Nehemiah 9:16–23*.
 - **B.** In the land of promise the people responded to God's goodness by rebelling—*Nehemiah 9:24–26.*
 - **C.** The Lord gave them over to the hands of their enemies but continued to be merciful toward them—*Nehemiah* 9:27–31.
- IV. Reestablishing a covenant with the Lord: The people restored their commitment to be in a covenant relationship with the Lord—Nehemiah 9:32–38.
