
This Month for Men & Women

Lesson 1: "How'd We Get in the Mess We're in?—*Romans 1:18–32*

Tom Rodgers, Lead Pastor

- Because God is angry: God is angry against men who defy the self-evident truth of His existence—Romans 1:18–20.
- **II. Because God expresses His anger:** God judicially abandons those who reject the self-evident truth of His existence to the deepening domination of their sinful natures —*Romans 1:21–32.*
 - **A.** Step #1—philosophical foolishness: Willful rejection of the self-evident truth of God's existence breeds illogical reasoning and dulled discernment—*Romans* 1:21.
 - **B.** Step #2—idolatrous substitutes: Philosophical foolishness causes sinful men to embrace a wide assortment of idolatrous substitutes—*Romans 1:22–23*.
 - C. Step #3—sexual immorality: God abandons idolatrous men to unbridled sexual experiences—Romans 1:24–25.
 - D. Step #4—sexual perversion: God turns immoral men over to the dishonorable trap of homosexuality—Romans 1:26–27.
 - **E.** Step #5—unbridled depravity: God eventually abandons perverse men to the experience of every imaginable form of evil, in spite of man's futile attempts to justify himself—Romans 1:28–32.
