

Lesson 30: Loving Others the Way Christ Loves Us—*John 13:18–35*

- I. Christ indicated that one of His disciples would betray Him that night—John 13:18–22.
 - **A.** Christ foretold that a trusted friend would betray Him—John 13:18–19.
 - **B.** Christ told His disciples that the betrayer would be one of them—*John 13:20–22*.
- **II.** Christ identified the disciple who would betray Him by offering the honored portion of the meal—John 13:23–30.
 - **A.** The one who would betray Christ is the one to whom He would give the "sop"—

 John 13:23–26a.
 - **B.** Once Christ gave Judas the "sop" Satan invaded Judas's body and it was dark outside and dark inside of Judas's heart—*John 13:26b–30*.
- **III.** Christ initiated a new command for His disciples to embrace—*John 13:31–35*.
 - **A.** Christ would bring glory to His Father through His death, burial and resurrection—

 John 13:31–32.
 - **B.** In light of Christ's absence, Christ commanded His disciples to love one another as He had loved them—*John 13:33–34*.
 - **C.** One of the strongest evidences that a person is a disciple of Jesus emerges when that individual loves others the way Christ loves people—John 13:35.
