

# **This Morning**

Lesson 42: The Betrayal—John 18:1-11

Tom Rodgers, Lead Pastor

I. The setting for the betrayal: The Lord Jesus convened with His disciples in the Garden of Gethsemane as their oft-visited location for spending time together—John 18:1.

II. The entrance of the betrayer: Judas Iscariot led a sizable group of Roman and Sanhedrin militia into the Garden of Gethsemane to seize Jesus—John 18:2–3.

III. The encounter in the betrayal: The Lord Jesus initiated contact with Judas and the accompanying militia and openly announced His identity as the One they came to arrest— John 18:4-8a.

IV. The protection during the betrayal: In the midst of His betrayal, the Son of God strategically provided protection for His eleven disciples—John 18:8b-9.

V. The focus during the betrayal: The Lord Jesus would not allow His betrayal to sidetrack Him from His mission to embrace the Cross—John 18:10–11.
