

Lesson 45: Dealing with the Truth—John 19:1–16

Tom Rodgers, Lead Pastor

I. Attempting to minimize the truth: Pontus Pilate unsuccessfully attempted to influence the Jewish mob to drop their charges against Jesus of Nazareth after He had been abused, mocked, and ridiculed—John 19:1–5.

II. Attempting to dodge the truth: Pilate unsuccessfully tried to weasel out of His responsibility to adjudicate the charges against the Son of God by relegating His judgment to the Jewish mob—John 19:6–8.

III. Attempting to dismiss the truth: The Procurator of Judea unsuccessfully tried to dismiss the charges against the God-man until the Jews threatened to report his impeachable actions to Emperor Tiberius—*John 19:9–12*.

IV. Attempting to appease the truth: Pontus Pilate unsuccessfully attempted to have the charges against the Nazarene dropped until he caved in to the unrelenting political pressure from the Jewish mob—*John 19:13–16*.
