



Lesson 1: Giving Thanks and Affirmation—2 Thessalonians 1:1–4

Reggie Coe, Marriage and Senior Adults Pastor

- **I.** Living in grace and peace: this letter picks up where the letter of 1 Thessalonians left off— 2 Thessalonians 2:1–2; see 1 Thessalonians 5:28.
 - **A.** Paul included his partners in ministry who joined him in building into the lives of the Thessalonians—2 Thessalonians 2:1; see 1 Thessalonians 1:1.
 - **B.** The grace of God provides us with a relationship that we could never earn but which the Lord freely gives—2 *Thessalonians 2:2a*.
 - **C.** The peace of God is the stability that He provides for those who have received His gift of grace—2 *Thessalonians 2:2b.*
- **II. Growing in faith and love:** The Thessalonian believers continued to grow in their relationship with the Lord and in their love toward one another—2 *Thessalonians 2:3*.
- **III.** Being steadfast in the midst of trials: The believers in Thessalonica embraced the Lord during trying times and exhibited steadfast endurance—2 *Thessalonians 2:4.*
 - **A.** Steadfastness in the midst of trials and suffering provides something worthy of affirmation—2 *Thessalonians 2:4a*.
 - **B.** Faith grows as we trust God to lead us through the trials and sufferings we face— 2 *Thessalonians 2:4b*.
 - C. Living in a fallen world means we will experience difficult circumstances through which the Lord will faithfully develop the steadfastness He wants to build into us— 2 Thessalonians 2:4c.
