



Lesson 3: Calming Fears about the Present—2 Thessalonians 2:1–4

I. The Thessalonians' fears: the church at Thessalonica was fearful they had "missed" the rapture and were living in the tribulation.

II. Paul's response: Paul responded to their concerns by reminding them of eternal truths about God's future plan.

A. Paul's assurance: Paul encouraged the Thessalonians not to be deceived that the day of the Lord had come.

B. Paul's reasons: Paul presented two (of three) reasons to justify his assurance.

III. Our reality: knowledge about what is coming encourages us because it allows us to set our fears aside to be who God has called us to be.
