THE HUMILITY OF MARY

Her Humble Life:

The angel's address to Mary indicates that she is a woman to whom God was directing His grace—*Luke 1:26–37*

Her Humble Response:

Mary's response of willing submission to the Lord and His plan demonstrated her accepting the part He was writing for her—*Luke 1:36*

Her Humble Praise:

Mary reflected on her humble position as God's maidservant as she praised Him for how He had blessed her by choosing her to be the one through whom the Messiah would come—*Luke 1:46–55*

Her Humble Acceptance of Circumstances:

Mary gave birth to the Messiah in a manger—*Luke 2:7*
