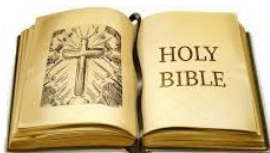

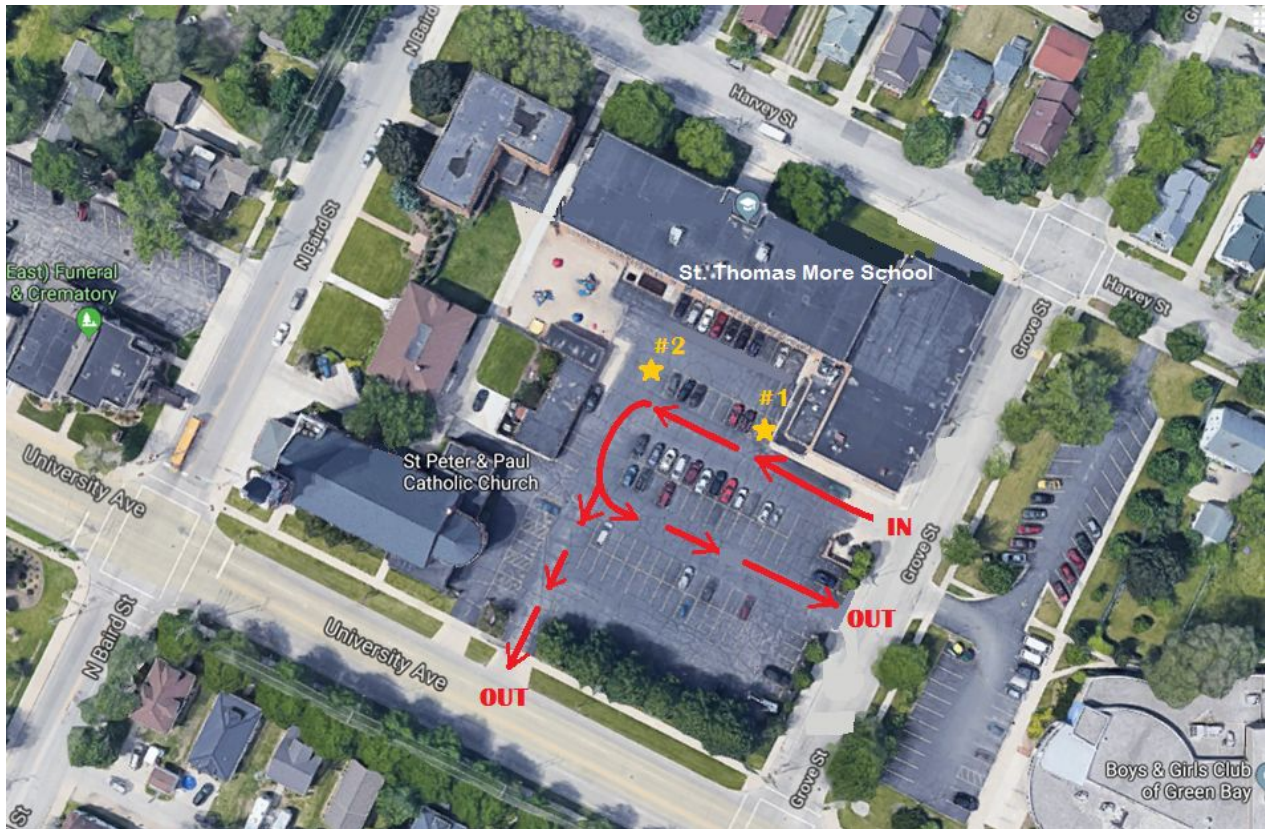
### Cure or Threat

**IMPORTANT CHANGES TO INCREASE SCHOOL SAFETY**  
**Effective March 1, 2019**



**Changes for Drop Off Procedures and Rules Effective March 1, 2019**

- **Enter only** from the north entrance of Gross St.; **Exit** onto Gross at the south end of the parking lot or University Ave. Follow the arrow directions and signs for entering and exiting the school
- Keep a single line at all times. Wait in line until the car in front moves forward.
- Move forward as soon as your children exit the car. (children should exit on the passenger side of the car)
- Elementary students are dropped off where star #1 is marked on the map.
- Middle school students are dropped off where star #2 is marked on the map.
- If you have students from both levels all can be dropped at the first stop. Middle school students will walk to door # 5.
- Do not drop off your students in other areas of the parking lot.
- If you choose to park in a stall then you must walk with your student to the door.
- If you choose to walk with your children to the door, you must park in a parking spot not just stop in the driving lane.
