Experience It! The Hermitage

A treasure trove for art lovers and historians alike, the Hermitage is one of the most impressive and expansive museums in the world. The museum started out as the personal collection of Catherine the Great, a royal known for her love of art and finer things. It's said that the museum was derived from the term "hermitage," a dwelling of a recluse, to denote the exclusivity of access to the museum. Eventually, the museum was opened to the public by Nicholas I in 1852. Today, the Hermitage's complex spans across five linked buildings and features over 3 million artworks and artifacts ranging in history from ancient Egypt to early 20th-century Europe. Uncover some of the world's finest masterpieces while being transported to Imperial Russia on a guided tour of this spellbinding museum.

Please Note:

IDENTIFICATION

Passports and visas are required for this tour at your expense. Certain countries require a minimum of 6 months passport validity from date of return home. You are strongly urged to contact the appropriate consulate for details. Visit www.travel.state.gov for the U.S. State Department for the latest details about passports and visa requirements.

IMPORTANT: We recommend that our guests traveling abroad take a photocopy of their passport and applicable visas. It should be packed separately from your actual passport and visa. We also

recommend leaving a copy at home with your emergency contact.

A visa is required for travel to Russia. It is the passenger's responsibility to obtain any required visa and/or documents prior to departure. Please allow a minimum of approximately 6 weeks for processing your Russian visa. All guests should check with the appropriate foreign consulate for additional entry requirements. All document fees are at the expense of the traveler.

Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

To complete your tour, we include roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times.

*When the Assumption Cathedral is not available, we will visit either the Cathedral of the Annunciation or the Cathedral of the Archangel.

Some of the touring days may be longer, with select included activities occurring later in the evening.
