Down to accomadations the master is on the port side with ensuete head and shower with crew bunk room to starboard. Forward to starboard is the second guest bunk room and day head. The VIPis forward with island queen and third head.

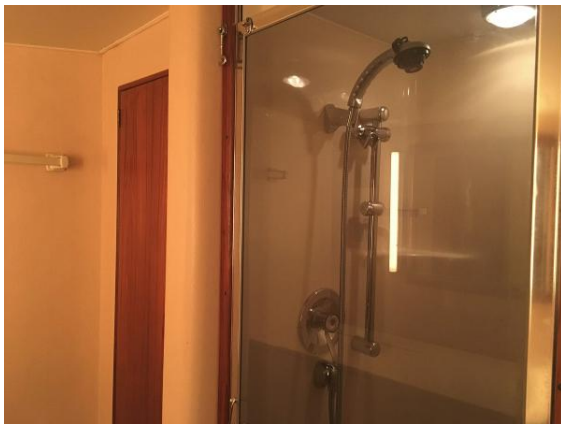

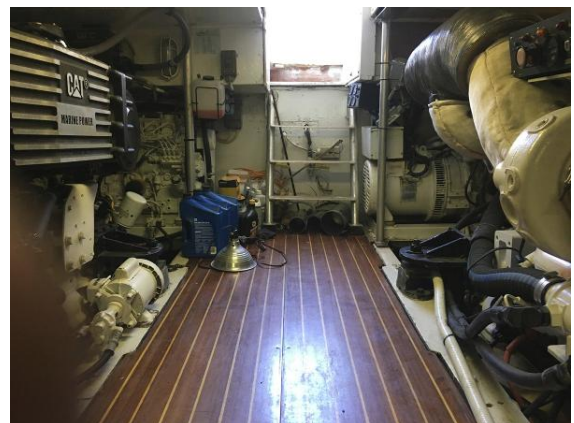
